Amigurumi The Nutcracker Lead Soldier Free Crochet Pattern: Craft Your Own Charming Character!

Today, we're thrilled to share a special **free pattern** for crafting your very own **amigurumi The Nutcracker Lead Soldier**. Inspired by the beloved tale, this project offers a magical opportunity to crochet a charming character straight out of the story. Whether you're a seasoned crocheter or a beginner eager to learn, this pattern is suitable for all skill levels. So, grab your crochet hook and let's embark on a journey to create a timeless masterpiece!

Materials:

Any yarn that is comfortable for you, the same thickness. Most of all goes red

and white flowers, the rest a little bit. Necessary colors: red, white,

fleshly, black, yellow, purple, brown. Hook for the selected

yarn.

In my case, Ethamine 30g / 180m (red) and forked jeans were used

YarnArt (50g / 160m). Hook number 0.9.

Natalya – Children's novelty from Pekhorka, Baby from Vita, yellow – Dream

(Trinity). Hook number 2

For design you will also need: foam rubber (4 cm thick in my case),

a little holofiber, thick cardboard, black floss, needle, maybe

the use of plastics, beads.

Abbreviations:

Ch – chain

Sl-st – slip-stitch

Sc – single crochet

Dc – double crochet

Inc – increase (2 columns with 1 loop)

Dec – decrease (knit 2 or 3 loops together)

HDC- half double crochet



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PATTERN

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch - chain
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BODY

Join the two legs with a sl st. Continue the rows.

25-26: 60 sc [60]

27: (8 sc, dec) [54]

28: 54 sc [54]

29: (7 sc, dim) [48]

30: 48 sc [48]

31: (6 sc, dec) [42]

32: 42 sc [42]

33: (5 sc, dec) [36]

34: 22 sc, change to black, 14 sc [36]

35: 22 sc, change to red, 14 sc [36]

36-38: 36 sc [36]

continue...

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32: 42 sc [42]

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continue...

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BODY:

Watch your knitting carefully. If you notice that the canvas anyway

moves, make an additional column for alignment.

White yarn: dial 24 ch

1 row: 1 inc, 21 sc, 4 sc in 1 loop, 21 sc, 1 inc = 50

2 row: 1 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc = 54

3 row: 2 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc = 58

4 row: 3 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc = 62

5 row: 3 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc = 66

6 row: 4 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc = 70

7 row: 5 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 10 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc = 74

8 row: 6 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 12 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc = 78

Circle the part on thick cardboard or plastic and cut. This item later
inserted into the body for strength.

9 row: 78 sc for the back half loop = 78, 1 sl-st

Change thread to red. Then knit in circular rows, but with a loop
lifting to reduce blade movement.

10-14 rows: 78 sc

Change thread to yellow.

15-17 rows: 78 sc

Count 13 sc, attach black thread, knit

1 row: 13 sc black yarn for the back half loop, 1 ch, inc

2 row: 13 sc, 1 ch, inc

3 row: 13 sc, 1 ch, inc

4th row: 13 sc. Break the thread.

The part should be in the front center.

Back to knitting the body.

Change thread to red.

18 row: 13 sc red, see black, 21 sc (3 sc on the side of the black part, 2

sc on the corner, 11 sc on the long side, 2 sc on the corner, 3 sc on the side

side), see red on, 52 sc = 86

19 row: 13 sc (red), 21 sc (black), 52 sc (red) = 86

20-34 rows: repeat row 19.

Attach the black thread to row 34, counting 17 loops from the beginning of the row.



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Knit:

1 row: 13 sc black yarn for the front half loop, 1 ch, inc

2 row: 13 sc, 1 ch, inc

3 row: 13 sc, 1 ch, inc

4th row: 13 sc. Break the thread.

Sew the sides of the part to the 4 black stitches left on each side.

Back to knitting the body.

Change thread to white.

35 row: 7 sc (white), 25 sc (beige), 46 sc (white) = 78

36-53 rows: repeat the 35 row

54-55 rows: 78 sc white

Shape and circle on paper. Mark the notch for the mouth.

Cut a piece of foam into the shape of the body, cut a recess for the mouth.

You can put a piece cut out of cardboard or plastic inside, you can even

stick, then foam. Well spread it inside. If desired, you can

stick cardboard or plastic inside the part around the mouth so that it holds

form.

56 row: (4 sc, 1 dec) * 13 times = 65

57 row: 65 sc

58 row: (3 sc, 1 dec) * 13 times = 52

59 row: 52 sc

60 row: (2 sc, 1 dec) * 13 times = 39

61 row: 39 sc

62 row: (1 sc, 1 dec) * 13 times = 26

63 row: 26 sc

Add holoffiber if necessary.

64 row: (3 sc, 1 dec) * 5, 1 sc = 21

65 row: 21 sc

66 row: (2 sc, 1 dec) * 5, 1 sc = 16

67 row: 8 decreases = 8



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LEGS

We start with the boots. Brown thread dial 13 ch

1 row: 11 sc, 4 sc in 1 loop, 10 sc, 1 inc = 27

2 row: 1 inc, 10 sc, 4 inc, 10 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc = 33

3 row: 1 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 hdc, 4 dc, (1 dc, 1 dc-inc) * 4, 4 dc, 1 hdc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc = 39

Circle the part on thick cardboard or plastic, cut 2 parts.

4 row: 39 sc for the back half loop

5-7 rows: 39 sc = 39

8 row: 10 sc, (1 dec, 1 sc) * 6 times, 1 dec, 9 sc = 32

9 row: 10 sc, . 6 dec, 10 sc = 26

Insert the cut part for density.

10 row: 11 sc, 2 dec, 11 sc = 24

11-14 rows: 24 sc

15 row: 24 sc for the front half loop

Then we knit in rotary rows, do not do 1 ch for lifting

16 row: 17 sc, 1 sl-st inc

17 row: 6 sc, 1 sl-st inc

18 row: 4 sc, 1 sl-st inc

19 row: 2 sc, 1 sl-st inc

20 row: 1 sc, 1 sl-st. Leave a tail for sewing.

Attach a white thread to a row of 15 boots for the back loop:

1-3 rows: 24 sc

4th row: (3 sc, 1 inc) * 6 times = 30

5-7 rows: 30 sc. Leave the thread for sewing. To fill.

HANDS

Beige yarn:

Thumb (2 pcs)

1 row: 6 sc magic ring

2-3 rows: 6 sc

Fingers (6 pcs)

1 row: 6 sc magic ring

2-4 rows: 6 sc

Stuff in the course of knitting.

Connect the fingers in the palm of your hand:

1 row: 3 sc (1st finger), 3 sc (2nd finger), 6 sc (3rd finger), 3 sc (2nd finger), 3

sc (1st finger) = 18

2-3 rows: 18 sc

For the right hand:

4th row: 14 sc, 3 sc of the thumb (grab on both sides), 1 sc = 18

For the left hand:

4th row: 1 sc, 3 sc of the thumb (grab on both sides), 14 sc = 18

5 row: 18 sc

6 row: (1 sc, 1 dec) * 6 = 12

7 row: 12 sc

Change thread to purple

8 row: (1 sc, 1 inc) * 6 = 18

9-11 rows: 18 sc

12 row: for the front half-loop (2 sc, 1 inc) * 6 = 24 Break the thread.

Attach the red thread to the back loop of row 11:

13 row: 18 sc = 18

14-23 rows: 18 sc

Change thread to yellow

24 row: 18 sc

25 row: (5 sc, 1 inc) * 3 = 21

26 row: 21 sc

27 row: (6 sc, 1 inc) * 3 = 24

28 row: 24 sc

29 row: behind the back loop 24 sc

Do not forget to stuff.

30 row: (2 sc, 1 dec) * 6 = 18

31 row: (1 sc, 1 dec) * 6 = 12

32 row: (1 dec) * 6 = 6

Mouline thread black embroider arches.

HOOD

White thread dial 9 ch

1 row: knit 8 sc, 1 ch, INC = 8

2 row: 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec = 6

3 row: 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec = 4

4 row: 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc = 3

Attach the purple thread and knit on the side of the part 2 rows of 4 sc.

Sew on.

EYES

White:

1 row: 6 sc magic ring

2 row: (1 inc) * 6 = 12

3 row: (1 sc, 1 inc) * 6 = 18

Tie sl-st with black thread for the back half-loop.

In black:

1 row: 6 sc magic ring. Sew on.

NOSE

Beige yarn

1 row: 6 sc magic ring

2 row: (1 sc, 1 inc) * 3 = 9

3 row: (2 sc, 1 inc) * 3 = 12

4 row: (3 sc, 1 inc) * 3 = 15

5 row: (4 sc, 1 inc) * 3 = 18

6 row: 1 sc, 1 triple decrease (3 in 1), 1 sc, 1 inc, (5 sc, 1 inc) * 2 = 19

7 row: 4 sc, 1 inc, (6 sc, 1 inc) * 2 = 22

Finish with sl-st, break the thread. Triple decrease should be from the bottom. To fill.

Sew on your nose.

HAIR

Curls (4 pcs)

White yarn

1 row: 6 sc into magic ring

2 row: (1 inc) * 6 = 12

3 row: (1 sc, 1 inc) * 6 = 18

4 row: 18 sc for the back loop

5-16 row: 18 sc

17 row: 18 sc for the back loop

To fill.

18 row: (1 sc, 1 dec) * 6 = 12

19 row: (1 dec) * 6 = 6

The tail (part 1)

White yarn

Dial 17 ch

1 row: 16 sc, 1 ch, inc

2-26 rows: repeat row 1 = 16

The tail (part 2)

White yarn

Dial 8 ch

1 row: 7 sc, 1 ch, inc

2-23 rows: repeat row 1 = 7

Sew part 1 with one side to the head approximately to row 54-55, the second side

pull off. Part 2, pull one of the sides and sew to the strained side of part 1.

Tie a black bow.

HAT

Front / rear (2 pcs)

Attention! There are rows in the part that do not fit perfectly. If you

there were loops – that's okay, it should be so.

Red yarn dial 39 ch

1 row: 38 sc, 1 ch, inc

2 row: 1 inc, 17 sc, 1 inc, 18 sc, 1 inc, 1 ch INC = 41

3-7 rows: 41 sc, 1 ch, inc

Then we do not do further 1 ch for lifting, but we turn the work on, skip 1 sl-st and

knit on.

8 row: 1 dec, 38 sc, 1 sl-st inc

9 row: prop. 1 loop, 18 sc, 1 inc, 17 sc, 1 sl-st inc

10 row: prop. 1 loop, 17 sc, 1 inc, 15 sc, 1 sl-st inc

11 row: prop. 1 loop, 32 sc, 1 sl-st inc

12 row: prop. 1 loop, 15 sc, 1 inc, 14 sc, 1 sl-st inc

13 row: prop. 1 loop, 29 sc, 1 sl-st inc

14 row: prop. 1 loop, 1 dec, 11 sc, 1 inc, 11 sc, 1 dec, 1 sl-st inc

15 row: prop. 1 loop, 1 dec, 10 sc, 1 inc, 10 sc, 1 dec, 1 sl-st inc

16 row: prop. 1 loop, 22 sc, 1 sl-st inc

17 row: prop. 1 loop, 10 sc, 1 inc, 9 sc, 1 sl-st inc

18 row: prop. 1 loop, 1 dec, 7 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 dec, 1 sl-st inc

19 row: prop. 1 loop, 1 dec, 6 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 dec, 1 sl-st inc

20 row: prop. 1 loop, 7 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 sl-st inc

21 row: prop. 1 loop, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 dec, 1 sl-st

Break the thread.

Side part

Black yarn dial 3 ch

1 row: 2 sc, 1 ch, INC = 2

2-6 row: 2 sc, 1 ch, inc

7 row: 1 sc, 1 inc, 1 ch INC = 3

8-9 row: 3 sc, 1 ch inc

10 row: 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc, 1 ch, INC = 5

11-15 row: 5 sc, 1 ch, inc

16 row: (1 sc, 1 inc) * 2, 1 sc, 1 ch, INC = 7

17-22 row: 7 sc, 1 ch, inc

23 row: (1 sc, 1 inc) * 3, 1 sc, 1 ch, INC = 10

24-38 row: 10 sc, 1 ch, inc

39 row: (1 sc, 1 dec) * 3, 1 sc, 1 ch, INC = 7

40-45 row: 7 sc, 1 ch, inc

46 row: (1 sc, 1 dec) * 2, 1 sc, 1 ch, INC = 5

47-51 row: 5 sc, 1 ch, inc

52 row: 1 dec, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 ch, INC = 3

53-54 row: 3 sc, 1 ch, inc

55 row: 1 sc, 1dec, 1 ch, INC = 2

56-60 row: 2 sc, 1 ch, inc

Bind the front and back to the side yellow thread with sc.

FEATHER

Yellow yarn

Dial 16 ch., From the second loop from the hook 9 sc, 2 hdc, 3 dc, increase from 6 dc,

3 dc, 2 hdc, 9 sc.

Link such parts 4 pcs.

Sew them to each other with an overlap.

Bead

Yellow yarn

1 row – 6 sc into magic ring

2 row – 6 inc (= 12)

3 row – (1 sc, inc) * 3 times (= 18)

Tie in a circle sl-st

BUCKLE BELT

Yellow yarn

6 ch., From the second loop from the hook

4 sc, in 1 loop we knit 1 sc, 1ch., 1 sc, 1 ch., 1 sc, 3 sc, in the last loop

1 sc, 1ch., 1 sc, 1 ch., Connect to the beginning of knitting.

TOOTH

Dial 14 ch.,

1 row: 13 sc, 1 ch, inc

2 row: 13 sc, 1 ch, inc

3 row: 13 sc. Break the thread.

Embroider a “septum” of teeth with a thread

BUTTONS (8 pcs)

6 sc in the ring with yellow thread, 1 sl-st. Break the thread, leave a little for

sewing on. The part can be glued or use half beads and sequins

instead of this.

Sew arms / legs to the body, sew hem and buckle. Sew the curls

pairwise lower part at the level of 35 rows.

Sew on your eyes. Embroider bangs. Sew a nose, embroider eyebrows.

Sew teeth. They can, as in my version, be molded from plastic and glued.

Hat a little stuffed and sewn. Sew a feather and a bead. Yellow yarn

to embroider a loop on boots. Glue or sew buttons on the sides: one

below the belt and three above.

When designing, we focus on frames from m / f

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
