With clear step-by-step instructions, plush yarn details, adorable mittens, a warm scarf, and a stylish hat, this snowman doll becomes a charming handmade gift or decoration. If you enjoy creating winter-themed toys or working with plush yarn like Himalaya Dolphin Baby, this crochet snowman pattern is the perfect project for your collection.

* MATERIALS

- 1: Yarn – Himalaya Dolphin Baby: • White – 1 skein • Grey – small amount for mittens & hat • Pink – small amount for hat & scarf
- 2: YarnArt Velour (or YarnArt Dolce Baby or any thin plush yarn) – for the nose
- 3: YarnArt Jeans in black – for the mouth
- 4: Safety eyes – **20 mm** with backing
- 5: Hooks: • **3.5 mm** main work • **3 mm** for nose
- 6: Stuffing – polyester fiberfill
- 7: Cardboard or plastic circle – to reinforce the bottom of the body
- 8: Marker, sewing needle, strong thread for shaping, scissors, large needle

9: Finished doll height: **28 cm** (including hat)

☐ ABBREVIATIONS

sc – single crochetch – chaininc – increasedec – decreasesl st – slip stitchFLO – front loop
onlyBLO – back loop onlyhdc – half double crochetPP – chainMR – magic ringPopcorn5 – puff
stitch with 5 pulls (instructions below)

Popcorn Stitch (Popcorn5)(5 hdc pulled into one foundation, closed into one top)

1: Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, pull up loop → 3 loops2: Yarn over, insert hook into same
stitch, pull up loop → 5 loops3: Repeat **3 more times** (total 5 pulls) → 11 loops4: Yarn
over, pull through 9 loops, leaving 2 loops5: Yarn over, pull through remaining 2 loops → one
top formed

* ARMS – Snowman Amigurumi

Start with mitten color.

1: MR, 6 sc2: (1 sc, inc) ×3 (9)3: (2 sc, inc) ×3 (12)4: 12 sc5: 12 sc

Right arm special row:6: 5 sc, Popcorn5, 6 sc (12)

Left arm special row:6: 6 sc, Popcorn5, 5 sc (12)

7: 12 sc

Switch to white yarn.

8: BLO 12 sc9: 3 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 3 sc (10)

Stuff mittens and arms.

10-17: 10 sc (8 rows)

Fold arm in half and crochet together: 5 sc across both sides. Fasten off.

Make cuff:12 sc in FLO of Row 8.

☐ BODY – Snowman Amigurumi

Stuff as you go.

1: MR, 8 sc2: 8 inc (16)3: (1 sc, inc) ×8 (24)4: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc) ×7, 1 sc (32)5: (3 sc, inc)
×8 (40)6: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) ×7, 2 sc (48)7: (5 sc, inc) ×8 (56)

Cut out a cardboard circle to match size.

8: BLO 56 sc9-13: 56 sc (5 rows)Insert cardboard.

Realign marker to avoid twisting.

14: (5 sc, dec) ×8 (48)15-16: 48 sc (2 rows)17: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) ×7, 2 sc (40)18-19: 40
sc (2 rows)20: (3 sc, dec) ×8 (32)21-24: 32 sc (4 rows)

Attach arms:

25: 6 sc, 5 sc through body + arm, 10 sc, 5 sc through body + arm, 6 sc (32)

26: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) \times 7, 1 sc (24)27-28: 24 sc (2 rows)

□ START OF HEAD

Align marker.

29: 24 inc (48)30: 12 sc, (1 sc, inc) \times 3, 12 sc, (inc, 1 sc) \times 3, 12 sc (54)31-34: 54 sc (4 rows)

Reposition marker so it aligns exactly at center of head.

35: 12 sc, (1 sc, dec) \times 3, 6 sc Place marker – this is head center (align with arms). Then continue: 6 sc, (dec, 1 sc) \times 3, 12 sc (48)

36: 3 sc, (1 sc, dec) \times 5, 3 sc (42)37-40: 42 sc (4 rows)41: (5 sc, dec) \times 6 (36)

□ EYE PLACEMENT – Snowman Amigurumi

From the center point in Row 35, move **up 2 rows**. Attach eyes between **Rows 37-38** spaced **8 stitches apart**.

42: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) \times 5, 2 sc (30)43: (3 sc, dec) \times 6 (24)44: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) \times 5, 1 sc (18)45: (1 sc, dec) \times 6 (12)46: 6 dec \rightarrow close ring.

□ NOSE – Snowman Amigurumi

Hook: 3 mm

1: MR, 4 sc2: 4 sc3: 2 dec

Leave long tail for sewing. Do not turn inside out. Pull MR tail through nose for shaping. Sew it so the nose aligns with the **lower edge of the eyes**.

□ FACE SHAPING

1: Insert needle between Rows **29-30**, in the center above increases.2: Bring needle under left eye, pass through points shown, then exit under right eye.3: Return to starting point. Pull tight.

Repeat:4: Insert needle in same start point, pass through side points of eyes, return again.5: Pull tight. Hide thread ends inside head.

□ HAT – Snowman Amigurumi

1: MR, 6 sc2-5: 6 sc (4 rows)6: (1 sc, inc) \times 3 (9)7-9: 9 sc (3 rows)10: (2 sc, inc) \times 3 (12)11-13: 12 sc (3 rows)14: (3 sc, inc) \times 3 (15)15-17: 15 sc (3 rows)18: (4 sc, inc) \times 3 (18)19-21: 18 sc (3 rows)22: (5 sc, inc) \times 3 (21)23-25: 21 sc (3 rows)26: (6 sc, inc) \times 3 (24)27-28: 24 sc (2 rows)29: (5 sc, inc) \times 4 (28)30: 28 sc31: (6 sc, inc) \times 4 (32)32: (7 sc, inc) \times 4 (36)33: 36 sc

Switch to additional color:

34: BLO (5 sc, inc) \times 6 (42)35: (5 sc, inc) \times 7 (49)36: (6 sc, inc) \times 7 (56)37: 56 sc38: 56 sl st

Sew hat around head color-change line.Shape the hat by bending it and stitching in place.

1: Ch 612: From 2nd ch → 60 hdc
